
How many Emergency Lights do I need?

The performance and placement of emergency lighting are critical elements to ensure occupants can identify their surroundings and evacuate safely.

NFPA 101 Life Safety Code (Section 7.9.2.1) outlines the initial illumination along the path of egress required for compliance.

Meet Illumination Requirements

- Average 1 Footcandle
- Minimum 0.1 Footcandle
- Max-to-Min Ratio 40:1 or less




Typical Path of Egress Parameters

Unit Mounting Height: 7.5' with a 9' Ceiling Height Reflectance: 80 / 50 / 20 Assumes open space with no obstructions
