

## Lumination<sup>®</sup> LED Emergency and Exit luminaires Two-Year Limited Warranty

Warranty IND699 Effective 10/1/22

Applies to Lumination® LED Emergency and Exit Luminaires purchased from Current beginning April 1, 2021.

**WARRANTY:** Subject to the terms and conditions of this Limited Warranty, Current Lighting Solutions, LLC ('Current') warrants that the Lumination® LED Emergency and Exit Luminaires ("Luminaire") and Emergency Batteries ("Battery"), whether sold separately, or in combination, (collectively, the "Product"), to the original purchaser, who purchased the Product directly from Current ("Purchaser"), will be free from defects in material and workmanship for the duration of the "Warranty Period" as provided below

LUMEL Series Emergency Light	Two (2) years from the date of manufacture
LUMELHL Series Emergency Light	Two (2) years from the date of manufacture
LUMELOD Series Emergency Light	Two (2) years from the date of manufacture
LUEL Series Edge-Lit Exit	Two (2) years from the date of manufacture
LUR Series Remote	Two (2) years from the date of manufacture
Nickel Cadmium Battery	Five (5) years; prorated from the date of manufacture
Lead-Acit Battery	Two (2) years; prorated from the date of manufacture

A Battery, whether sold separately, or as a component of the Product, will be considered defective only if it fails to perform for a full ninety (90) minutes during required annual testing as provided in the Specifications. This Limited Warranty applies only when (i) Products containing Batteries have been continuously connected to an AC input power source within ninety (90) days of the date of shipment from Current's facilities or (ii) Batteries sold separately have been placed in Products continuously connected to an AC input power source within ninety (90) days of the date of shipment from Current's facilities.

A Luminaire will be considered defective in material or workmanship only if more than fifteen percent (15%) of the individual LEDs in the Luminaire fail to illuminate during the Warranty Period. Current warrants to the Purchaser that the Luminaire finish will not exhibit cracking, peeling, excessive fading or corrosion during the Warranty Period.

**EXCLUSIONS:** This Limited Warranty is VOID if Purchaser or user fails to comply with any applicable instructions and recommendations of Current; if any components are replaced with components of other manufacturers; or if the Product is operated outside the specified electrical values or is subject to abnormal use or stress, including under/over voltage conditions, excessive switching cycles, and operation in environmental conditions (e.g., ambient temperature) outside normal specified operating range. Products must be properly handled, stored, wired, transported, installed, operated, and maintained in accordance with the applicable Specifications. Current shall have no responsibility for damage resulting from physical damage; exposure to adverse or hazardous chemicals or other substances; use of reactive cleaning agents and/or harsh chemicals to clean the Products; environmental conditions; vandalism; fire; power failure, improper power supply, power surges or dips, and/or excessive switching; fatigue failure or similar phenomena resulting from induced vibrations, harmonic oscillation or resonance associated with movement of air currents around the Product; animal or insect activity. Current shall not be responsible for any failure of Products that result from external causes, including, but not limited to, acts of God; improper power supply; fault or negligence of the Purchaser or user; improper or unauthorized use, installation, handling, storage, maintenance, alteration or service; any abuse, misuse, abnormal use or use in violation of any applicable standard, code or instructions for use in installations including those contained in the latest National Electrical Code (NEC), the Standards for Safety of Underwriters Laboratory, Inc. (UL), Standards for the American National Standards Institute (ANSI), in Canada, the Canadian Standards Association (CSA), Europe (CE), Australia (C-Tick); or any cause other than a defect in the material or workmanship of the Product itself.

Current shall have no responsibility under this Limited Warranty for any substantial deterioration in the Product finish that is caused by failure to clean, inspect, or maintain the finish of the Products. During the Warranty Period some staining, chalking, or fading may occur. This is normal aging of the finish and is not a manufacturing defect; therefore, it is not covered by this Warranty. Neither polycarbonate nor acrylic material used in the Products is warranted against yellowing, as yellowing may naturally occur over time due to normal

aging. If the Products are used on existing foundations, anchorages or structures, the Purchaser and/or the user is solely responsible for the structural integrity of such existing foundations, anchorages or structures and all consequences arising from their use.

**REMEDY**: If the Product(s) fail to meet the Warranty set forth above, then Current will, at its option, either (i) repair the defective Product, (ii) provide a free replacement Product or replacement parts, F.O.B. Current's warehouse, or (iii) refund the purchase price paid to Current for the Product or replacement parts. Any replacement Product or part will be comparable in function but may not be identical to the original. The replacement or repaired Product is warranted for the remainder of the original warranty period. Current is not responsible for labor and other costs associated with removal or reinstallation. Notwithstanding any other potential remedy described herein, if a Battery is determined to be defective during the applicable Warranty Period, Purchaser's sole and exclusive remedy shall be a prorated discount against the cost of a replacement Battery.





## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

This Limited Warranty is VOID if Purchaser or the user fails to comply with any applicable instructions and recommendations of Current, or if any of the Exclusions defined above apply. This Limited Warranty extends only to Purchaser, but Current will honor, under the terms of this Limited Warranty, valid warranty claims by Purchaser arising from a failure to meet the above warranty when the Product has been resold in new condition and used only by the original user. THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS VOID WITH RESPECT TO ANY PRODUCT WHICH IS NOT USED FOR THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH IT WAS DESIGNED OR IF ANY REPAIRS OR ALTERATIONS ARE MADE BY ANY PERSON NOT AUTHORIZED BY CURRENT IN WRITING.

The user must keep adequate records of operating history, maintenance, and/or testing and provided such records to Current upon request to substantiate that the Products have failed to comply with the terms of this Limited Warranty. The adequacy of records shall be determined in the sole discretion of Current. Adequate records for proof of operation/testing include, but are not limited to, National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 101-required periodic testing documentation.

HOW TO MAKE A WARRANTY CLAIM: Current must issue a Return Material Authorization (RMA#) for all requests for warranty review. To make a warranty claim, retain the failed Products and notify your Current sales or customer service representative in writing within thirty (30) days of the failure. After contacting Current and receiving an RMA number, Purchaser shall promptly return the Product after receiving instructions regarding if, when, and where to ship the Product. The Product must be returned within 10 days of receiving the RMA number, and the shipping box must be clearly marked with the RMA number. Failure to follow this procedure shall void this Limited Warranty. Current reserves the right to examine all failed Product to determine the cause of failure and patterns of usage and shall be the sole judge as to whether any Product is defective and covered under this Limited Warranty.

LIMITS OF LIABILITY: THE FOREGOING LIMITED WARRANTY CONSTITUTES THE SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE WARRANTY AND REMEDY OF THE PURCHASER AND THE SOLE LIABILITY OF CURRENT FOR THE PRODUCTS AND IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, WHETHER WRITTEN, ORAL, IMPLIED OR STATUTORY. NO WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE IS MADE OR IS TO BE IMPLIED. IN NO EVENT SHALL CURRENT BE LIABLE FOR ANY OTHER COSTS OR DAMAGES INCLUDING LOST PROFITS, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.

**RIGHT TO MODIFY OR DISCONTINUE LIMITED WARRANTY:** This Warranty is effective for the purchases of Products on or after the effective date set forth herein and is in consideration of and is expressly subject to and conditioned by the terms set forth herein. Current reserves the right to modify or discontinue this Limited Warranty without notice provided that any such modification or discontinuance will only be effective with respect to any Products purchased after such modification or discontinuance.
